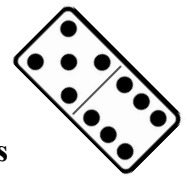
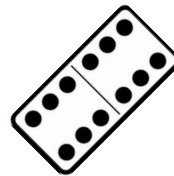
There will be a mail ballot election for School Board Trustees. Ballots as well as information on the candidates were mailed out on Tuesday April 22.
