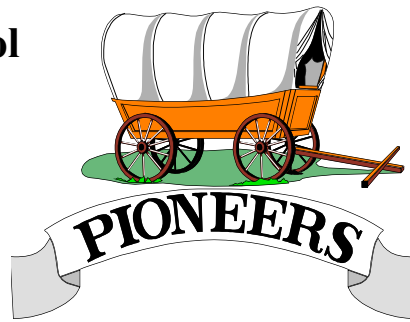

ENTRYWAY BEAUTIFICATION!!!

PTC supported \$500 for backdoor entry beautification with Craig, Corbin, and Alicia purchasing the plants/soil and getting the beds prepped while Justin updated the irrigation to a drip system! The new landscaping looks fabulous! **Thank you so much!**

Here is a list of what was planted:

- 1) Golden Currants (Ribes)- which flower very early (nondescript flower) and attract hummingbirds...the berries fruit in July and are edible and attract more birds. They get fall color. 4-6 ft tall and 3-6 ft wide (like a fan shape)
- 2) Serviceberry (Amelanchier) white spring blossoms, also edible but not sweet (unless you make jam with sugar)...typically less than 10 ft tall
- 3) Skunkbush Sumac (Rhus) - leafs out late - great fall color...typically 3ft by 3ft
- 4) Dwarf birch (Betula) shrub - typically 3ish ft as well - fall color
- 5) Spirea (the light green with flowers that was existing in each bed - were saved in place)
- 6) Blue bunchgrass (tried to save from existing planting)
- 7) Columbine (tried to save from existing planting)
- 8) Whipples Penstemon perennial flowers
- 9) Blanket flower (Gallardia) perennial
