Explorers

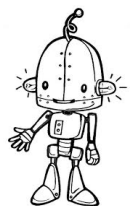
Explorers is our free Friday program which runs from 8am -6pm at the Community Center every Friday and is open to all students. Students need to bring a sack lunch.
