5 Board-Principal Relationship

7 The Board-Principal relationship is based on mutual respect for their complementary roles. The
8 relationship requires clear communication of expectations regarding the duties and
9 responsibilities of both the Board and the Principal.

11 The Board hires, evaluates, and seeks the recommendations of the Principal as the District chief
12 executive officer. The Board adopts policies necessary to provide the general direction for the
13 District and to encourage achievement of District goals. The Principal develops plans, programs,
14 and procedures needed to implement the policies and directs the District’s day-to-day operations.
