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18 Parents who wish to examine any assessment materials may do so by contacting the Principal.
19 Parental or legal guardian approval is necessary before administering an individual intelligence
20 test or a diagnostic personality test. No tests or measurement devices which include questions
21 about a student’s or the student’s family’s personal beliefs and practices in family life, morality,
22 and religion will be administered, unless the parent or legal guardian gives written permission for
23 the student to take such test, questionnaire, or examination.

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25 The Principal shall prepare an annual report which reflects the degree to which District goals and
26 objectives relate to the instructional program have been accomplished. The Principal shall
27 annually review the assessment processes and procedures to determine if the purposes of the
28 evaluation program are being accomplished.
